The expansion of the existing KSU English building became the centerpiece for redefining this portion of the campus. The extension of the campuses existing pedestrian and bicycle trail system reconnected this node back into the overall campus. Planned as the centerpiece of the northern campus expansion, the English Buildings redevelopment will serve as an anchor to a new great lawn and promenade.

The new classroom and office addition created a new elevated courtyard and allowed for the expansion of the campuses existing outdoor performance venue and cafe. In addition, the plan calls for the enhancement of an existing memorial and seating area.

Critical to the success of the project was an accelerated design/build schedule that called for project completion in a mere nine months in order for the facility to be operational for the following academic year.
